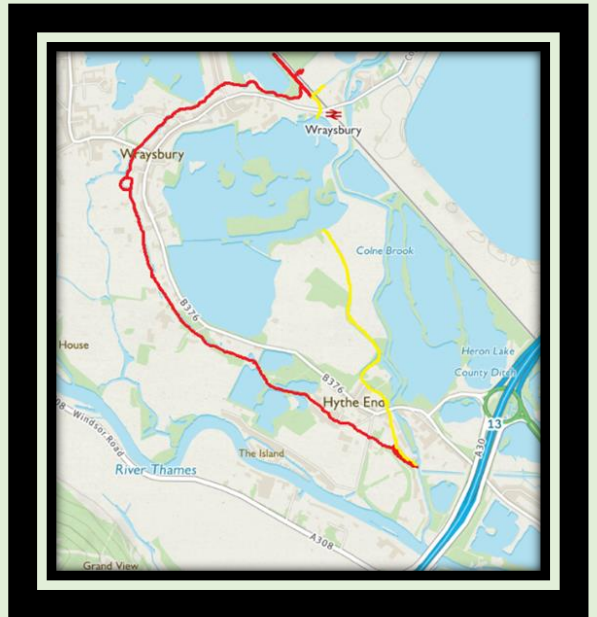

The Wraysbury Drain is two miles of important channel starting near Wraysbury Station and joining the Colne Brook at Hythe End.



- Land drainage infrastructure **regulates the water levels** and is **vital to the environment.** This watercourse has **STOPPED FLOWING.**
- In fact some land owners have **FAILED TO MAINTAIN** their watercourses.
- Furthermore the Lead Local Flood Authority has **FAILED TO USE ENFORCEMENT POWERS** to rectify the problems.
